Collect participant's perception about the curriculum topics, appointments modality, and resources guides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* How did this curriculum allow you to follow your interests?</li> <li>* Briefly review the curriculum topics' list to activate background knowledge:</li> <li>* Which topic in the curriculum was more relevant for you? Why?</li> </ul> <p>Suggested questions to start conversation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* How did this program help to expand your household education possibilities?</li> <li>* How did our appointments help to increase your awareness or confidence to prevent online scam for taxes or housing?</li> <li>* How does this program expand your ideas/resources about health, wellness, and after school and summer activities?</li> </ul> <p>Then ask:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Would you suggest new topics to include in a curriculum like this in the future?</li> <li>* Did you read or share any resource guide after our appointment?</li> <li>* What were your main challenges to attend your monthly appointments? How could we better support you to participate in this kind of curriculum?</li> <li>* Would you recommend continuing online or in-person appointments?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Conduct a semi-structured interview with guided questions. Inform your questions with participant's intake form interests</li> </ul>
